Minister of Communications and Information Technology issues this Order.

ORDER

Art. 1

As of the date of this Order, **DigiSign SA** becomes accredited provider of qualified certification services in accordance with the provisions of Art. 36 of Law no. 455/2001 on electronic signature and of art. 16-20 of the Technical and methodological rules for the implementation of Law no. 455/2001 on electronic signature, approved by Government Decision no. 1259/2001.

Art. 2

This order shall be served to **DigiSign SA** within 5 days, both on paper and electronically, digitally signed.

Art. 3

The status of accredited provider of qualified certification service is granted to **DigiSign SA** for a period of 3 years as of the date of this Order, subject to the provisions referred to in Art. 1.
